- **Keep it simple:** Opt for games with easy-to-understand rules that don't require a lot of preparation.

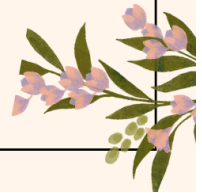
Classic Games with a Twist

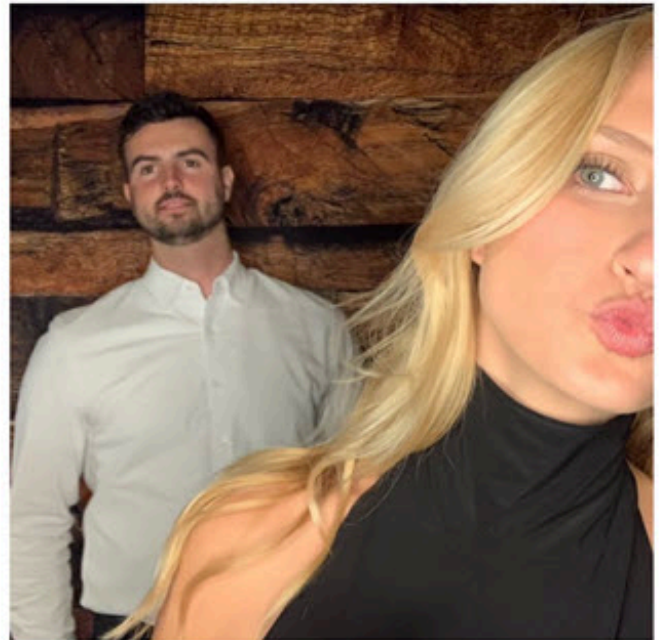
